Completion of NCB-approved PRSS training program

Passing score on the PRSS certification exam

SUPERVISION STANDARDS

475 hours of supervised work/volunteer experience

Must include 25 hours of direct supervision

Please review NCB for requirements and application

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Completion of a PRSS Training Curriculum approved by the Nevada Certification Board
- 500 hours of volunteer or paid work experience
- 25 hours of supervision by a certified supervisor
- Passage of the IC&RC Peer Recovery Examination
- Agreeing to the PRSS Code of Ethics
- Must live or work in Nevada at least 50% of the time
